

City of Richmond 2007-2008 Residential Leaf Collection Program

The City of Richmond Department of Public Works is pleased to provide its first cycle for residential leaf collection services. Collection will begin November 5, 2007. If you intend to take advantage of the vacuum collection schedule listed below, please:

- ♦ Rake leaves to your property line.
- ♦ DO NOT rake leaves into the street.
- ♦ Leaves must be placed out for collection by the start date indicated for your route.
- ♦ Keep leaf piles less than 2 feet in height.
- ♦ Keep leaves away from ditches, pipes, and culverts.
- ♦ NO DIRT, ROCKS, BRICKS, METAL OR BRANCHES
DEBRIS IN LEAF PILES WILL PREVENT CREWS FROM COLLECTING YOUR LEAVES

The collection schedule may be affected by bad weather. For up-to-date information, call the Leaf Hotline at 646-LEAF. Collection crews will make every effort to service all residential streets. However, some conditions beyond our control may prevent us from reaching every home.

Can't Wait?

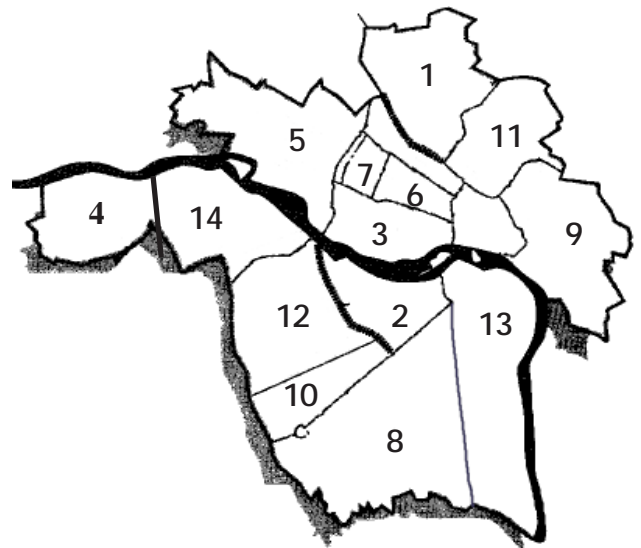
"Bag-and-Go" (BAG) We'll take away leaves placed in bags next to your Supercan on your regular scheduled trash pick up day. There's no limit! This program will end March 30, 2008.

Year-Round Pick Up: We'll collect up to six bags of leaves placed next to your Supercan on your regular trash day throughout the year!

Special Pick Up: If you miss your date you may schedule a special pick up by calling 646-0999. Cost is \$75.00

Dates listed above are *start dates* for each zone.

To ensure that your leaves are collected you must place them by the curb no later than the dates listed for each cycle. If you miss the first cycle pick up wait for the second cycle to begin or call for a special pick up at a cost of \$75.00
