



- ① **4400 Brook Road** • At the corner of Brook and Windsor, you'll find a garden in the fourth year of our care. Divided into equal parts sun and shade, you'll wander from mounded lavender and creeping thyme to the lush green of fern and hosta. Abound with scent and color, perennials and native plantings are blooming in anticipation of your arrival.
- ② **1217 Westminster Avenue** • Sun-baked backyard generously stuffed with Joe Pye weed, goldenrod and iron weed, wrapped in azalea, boxwood, ornamental grasses and Franklin trees and lightly dusted with lemon and banana. On the side we have woodland path primavera with a fresh meadow garnish. This is all served on a bed of mixed greens and awaits your sampling.
- ③ **1219 Westminster Avenue** • Come visit this simple but quaint shaded backyard which has a wonderful combination of flowers, peonies, hosta, rhododendron, boxwood and roses. The back yard also has apple, pear, crabapple and dogwood trees and the Cunningham Fir is always a curiosity. The front yard has a Kousa dogwood which is exquisite in full bloom.
- ④ **4526 Newport Avenue** • Our garden is both old and new with annuals and perennials galore. The lower garden path offers a colorful and relaxing stroll.
- ⑤ **4201 Crestwood Road** • Lovely terraced yard with mature plantings, as well as still emerging wildflower, shade, and water gardens. Two patios, a pond, and a stone fireplace make this a unique and relaxing setting.
- ⑥ **1610 Bellevue Avenue** • Large park-like backyard features a Lily garden and 50 year old Boxwood hedge. Numerous beds contain Canna Lilies, Swamp Hibiscus, Iris, Echinacea, Oriental Poppies and Ornamental grasses to name a few. Yard is complemented by a variety of herbs, quaint garden shed, bird baths and fruit trees.
- ⑦ **3913 Hermitage Road** • Large corner lot with some old and lots new—a work in progress! Enchanting tree house, (2 levels) inside a huge magnolia, beautiful custom fence and deck. Hostas, acuba, shade wildflowers, camellias, solomons seal, a peony, pink honey suckle and more.
- ⑧ **4022 Monticello Street** • Taming exciting bamboo made way for a meditation deck. The bamboo was then used for a privacy screen, a hand made fountain, borders and stakes. The several garden beds are filled with perennials and annuals that spread their bloom over 11 months. Gardens and green grass invite our children to play and enjoy nature.
- ⑨ **4023 Clinton Avenue** • This backyard shade garden provides color 9 months out of the year with its blend of foliage, perennials and annuals. Come visit us and see what is blooming now.

- ⑩ **4021 Clinton Avenue** • Not formal or fancy, but a pleasing mix of faithfully performing perennials including hostas, lilies, ferns, hellebores, bleeding heart, lady's mantle, veronica and ornamental grasses. Shrubs include boxwood, azaleas, nandina and arborvitae. Coleus and impatiens add summer color and a fountain adds the splash. Best of all, the backyard is easily accessible to walkers, wheelchairs and strollers.
- ⑪ **1417 Bellevue Avenue** • A garden filled with perennials, annuals, ponds and frogs both real and fake. The garden also has a nice selection of fruit trees and dogwoods.
- ⑫ **1410 Bellevue Avenue** • Started from scratch 7 years ago. The garden is filled with an exciting and unique blend of plants. A collectors garden.
- ⑬ **4020 Newport Avenue** • A cottage garden begun last fall. Charming front and back gardens are filled with perennials such as Hollyhocks, Roses, Black Eyed Susan's, Peonies and Flax.
- ⑭ **1321 Nottoway Avenue** • There are over 30 bonsai in this garden. They range from 10 to more than 30 years old. They include junipers, pines, maples, elms, and azaleas.
- ⑮ **1213 Claremont Avenue** • This garden has been a work in progress since the house was first built in the early 1930's. Each owner has left their own unique imprint. Today you will find a small cottage garden filled with reminders of the generosity of family and friends.
- ⑯ **1211 Claremont Avenue** • This garden features a rose-covered arbor, brilliant rows of day lilies, and a culinary herb garden. Beneath the shade of a silver maple, oak and holly trees, the backyard is landscaped with viburnums, impatiens, rhododendrons, astilbes, and numerous hostas.
- ⑰ **1213 Greycourt Avenue** • A relaxing cottage garden of mature perennials, a small pond, sitting areas and a bit of whimsy here and there.
- ⑱ **3900 Fauquier Avenue Median Strip** • Feeling the urge to plant with nowhere to go—no sun for our tomatoes. We opened the front doors and behold there was a median strip waiting to be planted. Seven households on the 3900 block have tilled and toiled, weeded and seeded to produce a virtual garden in the middle of the city. Stroll by and visit our little piece of farmland—quick before the squirrels eat all the tomatoes.
- ⑲ **3850 Fauquier Avenue** • A young eclectic garden filled with perennials and annuals Three years ago the yard was a blank slate, the challenge has been enjoyed.
- ⑳ **1214 W. Laburnum Avenue** • A delightful sunny garden of hybrid tea roses and annuals, mostly impatiens and geraniums.
- ㉑ **1609 W. Laburnum Avenue** • 3 dimensional art in a city garden.
