WHEREAS, the intersection of Hermitage Road and Laburnum Avenue is located in a populous residential area of the City; and

WHEREAS, the intersection of Hermitage Road and Laburnum Avenue, although the site of the statue of A. P. Hill, is not currently configured as a roundabout; and

WHEREAS, it is the consensus of the Council that it is in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Richmond that the intersection of Hermitage Road and Laburnum Avenue not be configured as a roundabout in the future; and

WHEREAS, section 2-454 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2004), as amended, requires an appropriate study by the City's Traffic Engineer prior to the adoption of an ordinance regulating motor vehicle traffic within the city; and

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That the installation or maintenance of a roundabout at the intersection of Hermitage Road and Laburnum Avenue is hereby prohibited.

§ 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.
